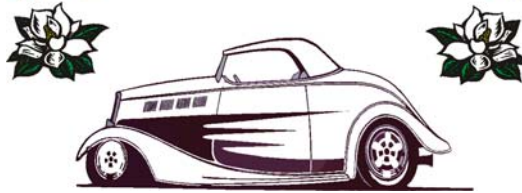

| 6 - Skinless, boneless chicken breast halves | 1 - 16oz sour cream                    |
| 1 - Can cream of mushroom soup               | 1 - Envelope Lipton Dry Onion Soup Mix |

Mix chicken and soups together and put into Crockery Pot. Cook on low for 4 to 6 hours or until chicken is tender. Stir in the sour cream when finished.
