Treasurer’s Report – Carol reported that our December 31, 2010 checking account balance was \$4,364.05. January income (dues/new member fees) was \$1315 with expenses totaling \$153.28. This left us with a balance of \$5,525.77 as of January 31, 2011. Motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept report.

Old Business:

- 1) Deposit was made to City of Pascagoula to reserve Beach Park for May 21, 2011.
- 2) Club Dinner – had a great turn-out and everyone seemed to have a good time.

New Business: Regarding our upcoming car show, John asked for Committee members who served last year, and might be willing to help again, to please get with him after the meeting.

Ron Crocker is a new grandfather.

Bobby Hand inquired about the Street Rod Show; not sure whether they will be setting up in parking garage, parking lot on side, or where. John will check on it and also get information on whether it would be feasible to get a hospitality room, the cost, size, etc.

Jerry Martin asked about the access we have to the building we meet in. Members pay \$100 per year for the room; at other times, if the room is not being used, we can use it. The normal charge is \$25 each time it’s used but, thus far, the Chamber has waived the Club’s fee because of us helping them.

Cruise-Ins start in March; we need to begin advertising, check with Northrop Grumman about getting the lights. Debbie McClendon did it last year.

Hoops on Market Street having a Corvette Cruise-In in near future.

Motor Sports is a good place to get a list of upcoming car shows; John will check it out.

Minutes of regular meeting – March 7, 2011

Sgt-at-Arms Jimmy Spicer called meeting to order and turned meeting over to President John Devera.

Minutes from February 7th meeting were read. Motion made, seconded, and approved to accept.

In absence of Treasurer, John gave Treasurer's report. February 2011 checking account balance, including \$240 in membership dues, is \$5,756.97.

Old Business:

- 1) Street Rod Show – March 18th thru 20th, Friday thru Sunday at Isle of Capri. John reported on a Hospitality Room: just a regular room would run \$99 per night, or we can get a Jr Suite for Friday & Saturday night at a total cost of \$375. It has a sitting area for maybe 10 to 12 people and may be on the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th floor; would have to leave show to get to it and then would have to have someone posted there in order to get in and out. After much discussion and weighing all the pros and cons, members voted to forego the hospitality room this year. City of Biloxi owns parking area on West side and we can put up canopies there and bring food. Will check this out and zero in on an area that would be closest to the show and check on the power. If no power outlets, can bring a generator. Restrooms are readily available in the casino. Also, if it rains, we can go in the lobby. Motion was made, seconded, and approved to cancel the hospitality room.

The show has only one entrance and you have to register to go in; don't know about motor homes.

Feel sure there will be security of some sort; don't know just what since the property belongs to the City. Registered cars should have a sticker or some form of identification so they can come and go.

Some are going over Friday; John will send out an e-mail to see if members want to meet at Lowe's around 11:00 AM and travel in a group. Will also check out the food situation, whether there are vendors, or we will be able to bring our own food.

- 2) Member's dues are overdue. Kala will send out reminders and if you know anyone that hasn't paid, please contact them.
- 3) Reminder of our Cruise-in the fourth Saturday of this month; NGS gave approval to use parking lot; Debbie will contact Maintenance to be sure we have lights. Need to check on plaques for our monthly Cruise-ins – will need six. Also need door prizes; have some from GCDS
- 4) Car Show – May 21st: we have fliers to pass out at other car shows; can also print off Web Site. Have sponsor letters ready; will get a list of Companies that gave door prizes last year and give to Don and Kathy Riddle, who volunteered to solicit prizes. Betty Carter is working on food vendors – The Shed need measurements to see if trailer will fit. Need more than one vendor; looking at someone for hamburgers, hot dogs, ice cream. Going to check with Hurley Methodist Church for \$6 dinner plates. They also will need to check on a permit with the City to sell food on City property.

New Business:

- 1) Danny said that Advance Auto in Hurley still wants us to come up there.
- 2) Welcome new members – Kenny and Debbie Novak with 1999 Corvette
- 3) April 2nd – Bellingrath Gardens – info on Web Site
- 4) April 9th – Old Fashioned Day in Hurley
