Apple Cake (Thank you Mary Rowell for this Recipe)

3 large eggs
1 ¼ c. oil
2 c. sugar
2 ½ c. self-rising flour
2 medium apples
1 c. shredded coconut
1 c. chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350. Blend eggs, oil, & sugar until creamy. Add flour a little at a time. Blend well. Batter will be stiff. Fold in apples, coconut, & pecans. Pour into greased & floured tube or Bundt pan. Bake 1 hr. Let cool @ 30 minutes & remove from pan. Top warm cake with frosting:

Frosting: ½ stick butter, ½ c. brown sugar, 1/3 c. milk. Mix all 3 ingredients in a saucepan. Boil 3 min. Pour over warm cake.
