

For the Ladies

Coconut Pie

1 cup sugar	1 ½ cup Milk
4 TBS flour	3 Egg Yolks (save white for topping)
¼ tsp salt	1 Cup Coconut
1 Lg can of Pet Milk	1 tsp coconut extract

Pre-bake pie shell set aside

Pie Filling Mix flour, sugar and salt together, add milk and egg yolks. Place on low heat stir continually until mixture begins to thicken. Remove from heat, add Coconut and coconut extract return to heat and continue to cook on low heat. When mixture has thickened, pour into a pre-baked pie shell. Let cool about 10 minutes and cover with meringue. (See Below)

Meringue: In a bowl combine egg whites and ¼ teaspoon Cream of Tarter. Beat until frothy. Slowly beat in ¼ cup sugar, beat until stiff and sugar dissolves. Spoon meringue on top of pie filling. Be sure to completely cover filling. Bake 8-10 minutes until lightly browned. Watch carefully that meringue doesn't burn. (I actually turn oven to broil move oven rack to middle and slide pie in and keep oven door open. Slowly turn pie as meringue browns usually only takes about 30 seconds or so to do this.
